

### [How are the two Sunday worship services different?](#)

The 8:30 am worship service features hymns on organ or piano. This service tends to be smaller and contemplative. Worship leaders are vested (wearing robes). The structure of the service is provided in a paper bulletin, which will direct you to specific pages of the Hymnal or The Book of Common Prayer during the service. Hymnals and Prayer books are provided for you in the pews. This service usually lasts less than an hour.

The 10:00 am worship service features modern worship music on keyboard and guitar. This service is energetic and lively. The words to the songs, scriptures and prayers are projected on a screen. Worship leaders are wearing regular clothes (not vested). This service usually lasts about 70 minutes.

Both services are located in the sanctuary, include the same scripture readings and sermon, and celebrate Holy Eucharist.
