What are the learning opportunities for children and youth?

On Sundays, we provide a weekly curriculum with an engaging and strategic approach that addresses the needs and interests of kids and teens. To participate, check in at the SJCKids table in the hallway or have your kids follow our SJCKids director as she calls the children in from family fellowship on the lawn. This happens at 10am.

SJCkids is our ministry to children ages 0-5th grade. We create engaging, Christ-centered environments that kids love so that they can grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus. We utilize First Look and 252 curriculum from Orange, along with many vetted and background-checked leaders to provide life-giving ministry.

How do we break out age groups? 0-2 years old is in our nursery, 3-5 years old is in our preschool room, K-3rd grade gathers in our big fellowship hall (Elebash Hall), 4th grade and up enjoy time in our upstairs Loft)

How do I pick up my kids? At the 10am service, kids ages 3 years old and up are brought to you in the church service just before communion. Children in the nursery and children at the 8:30 service can be picked up at the end of the church service.

One Sunday evening a month during the school year, our Youth Group (called United) meets from 600—730pm for youth in grades $4^{th} - 8^{th}$.
